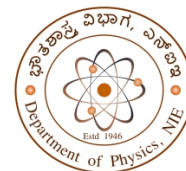

### **National Science Day 2021 - National level competition**

**Name of the Competition:** Best out of Waste

**Theme:** Science and Technology

**Brief Details of Competition:** With the growing increase in wastes in our society from households to industrial wastes, we now require a very innovative approach to get rid of them. Recycling and reusing the valuable waste material can result in development of fantastic and usable products. This competition requires use of creative skills by the participants highlighting role of Science and Engineering as a basis of designing. Everyday Wastes such as plastic, glasses, newspapers or electronic wastes can be used to create some technical model.

Best three models will get attractive prizes. The decision of judges is final. Prize winning videos will be uploaded in the Department of Physics, NIE, Mysore official YouTube Channel. The results will be announced on National Science Day 2021 celebration function to be held on March 03, 2021.

**Eligibility:** Undergraduate level students.

**Basic Rules:**

- The competitors may participate individually or as a team.
- Waste material could be anything like tetra packs, bottles, newspapers, old utensils, jute material or any second hand items that otherwise would be thrown away.
- The participant has to make a short video of the model along with the explanation of the waste things utilized and its application.
- Participants will be judged on creativity, utilization of resources, artistic composition & design, Eco-friendly rating, utility of the model and overall presentation.

**Last date to upload the video:** 28<sup>th</sup> February 2021

**Video Time limit:** 5 minutes

**Video Size limit:** 250 MB

**Note:** Participants may use video compressing software/apps for reducing the size of the video.
