Teaching Assistantship Scheme (TAS) for full time Ph.D. Students

The ever changing dynamics of higher education and recent ask for innovation and design thinking based pedagogical approach has prompted the academic community to devise thoughtful strategies, so as to synergize academic delivery with research expertise. Accordingly, introducing an appropriate teaching assistantship programme may be visualized as an impactful strategy towards creating a thoughtful platform towards empowering the academic careers of research intense students. Thus, NIE has initiated such an impactful activity at the Ph.D. level. Going forward, we believe that such a teaching assistantship programme would enable a holistic value addition to academic delivery.

Procedure for Teaching Assistantship (TA)

1. Currently (academic year 2020 to 2021), the assistantship is to be initiated only in Chemistry and Physics departments, which may however be extended to other departments in times to come and subject to administrative and finance approval.
2. Only full-time Ph.D. scholars, registered under The National Institute of Engineering, Mysuru, are eligible to apply.
3. Assistantships are awarded on semester-to-semester basis for a period of 3 years (extendable to 4 years) or until the submission of Ph.D. thesis, whichever is earlier.
4. Only laboratory work load of 7 to 8 hrs per week to be given with the financial support of Rs. 15,000/- per month.
5. Scholar should apply for teaching assistantship in the beginning of the semester against the notification made by the department.
6. After the selection of TA, every semester, as soon the time-table is announced, Ph.D. scholar is expected to report immediately to the Head of the Department.
7. A teaching assistant is expected to be regular towards the job (s) assigned to him/her.
8. A teaching assistant must mark his/her attendance in department attendance register on every working day (allotted to him).
