6.3. The minimum Credit Requirement for the M. Tech. is 88 and for M.C.A. is 100.	6.3. The minimum Credit Requirement for the M. Tech. is 80 and for M.C.A. is 100.
9.7. X Grade: This grade is a transitional grade which denotes incomplete grade. A student having satisfactory attendance and having high CIE rating ($\geq 90\%$) in a course, but SEE performance is poor, which could result in an overall 'F' grade in the course, will be awarded this grade. The DC can consider the request of any such student for a make-up examination and depending on the merit of the case and in consultation with the course instructor permit him/her to appear for make-up examination. The 'X' grade would be converted into one or the other of the letter grades (S/A/B/C/D/E/F) after the student completes the course requirements.	Deleted *

Make-up Examination [X and I grades]: The Make Up Examination facility would be available to students who may have missed to attend the SEE of one or more courses in a semester for valid reasons and given the 'I' grade; Also, students having the 'X' grade shall also be eligible. This facility can be availed by P.G. students only twice during their programme. The make up examination would be held as per dates notified by the CoE. Make up examination could be held at any time in the semester with the approval of the Principal. In all these cases, the standard of SEE would be the same as the regular SEE.</p> <p>All the 'I' and 'X' grades awarded to the students would be converted within two days of the respective make-up examinations to appropriate letter grades.
