- Sub.: 1. Amendment to clauses of Vertical progression of Academic Regulations for B.E. programme: 2021-22 admitted students.**
2. Schedule of Extension of Course Registration

With reference to the VTU circular – VTU/BGM/Aca-OS/Cirs/ 2022-23/4153 dated: 16.11.2022, relaxation has been given in the vertical mobility requirements (Ref: NIE Academic Regulation - 11.9.) due to possible introduction of new scheme from the academic year 2022-23.

The vertical mobility requirements are amended as follows:

All the below clauses are subject to a maximum duration of eight (for Regular Students) / six years (for Lateral Entry Students) as applicable.

11.9. 1(b) Students having not more than four backlog courses (Backlog courses includes courses with W & F grades and Not Registered / Dropped courses) in the 1st and 2nd semesters of the first year of the program shall be eligible to move to the 3rd semester (2nd year) of the program.	11.9. 1(b) Carry over of backlog courses: From 1 st semester till 6 th semester, the student/s who have any number of backlog courses (Backlog courses includes courses with W & F grades and Not Registered / Dropped courses) is allowed to move forward to the next semester (odd/even) . However, for the award of degree, the student must pass all the courses as per applicable schemes and regulations and earn the prescribed credits. This is subject to the permitted maximum duration as mentioned in the regulation.
11.9. 3. It may also be noted that the student will be given admission to the IV year (7th semester/ 8th semester) provided he/she passes all courses of 1st and 2nd semesters.	11.9. 3. No change

<p>11.9. 5 Permitted Maximum credits for registration: The student shall be permitted to register for courses not exceeding 28 credits. These 28 credits include the courses of the regular semester and backlogs. The registration of these additional credits includes the courses having a shortage of attendance and the courses whose CIE requirements are not fulfilled. A student has to pay the prescribed fee as notified by the Institute from time to time.</p>	<p>11.9. 5 Permitted Maximum credits for registration: The students shall be permitted to register for courses not exceeding 30 credits during any semester. These 30 credits include the courses of the regular semester and backlogs (W Grade- the courses having shortage of attendance and the courses whose CIE requirements are not fulfilled). A student has to pay the prescribed fee as notified by the Institute from time to time.</p>
<p>7.1. A student has to register for a minimum of 16 credits of regular semester. The maximum number of credits a student can register in a semester is 28.</p>	<p>7.1. A student has to register for a minimum of 16 credits of regular semester. The maximum number of credits a student can register in a semester is 30.</p>

Extension of Course Registration:

1. Those students who are eligible as per this circular are hereby informed to **pay the institute fee with penalty for the Academic year 2022-23** and previous dues (if any) **on or before 21.11.2022.**
2. **The students who have already done the provisional course registration also have to pay the institute fee on or before 21.11.2022 .**
3. Also, the students who are eligible as per this circular and not done the provisional course registration so far are hereby informed to **complete the course registration for III semester through proctor by paying the penal fee as per the Dean AA circular dated: 16.11.2022.**

Note: The Institute fee has to be paid according to the circular from Office of Principal dated: 27.09.2022.
