PROCESS OF APPOINTMENT

- The process of recruitment of **Research Professor, Professor and Associate Professor** is devised as follows:
 - The applications received are scrutinized by a committee consisting of HoD and two senior staff of the concerned Department. Based on this scrutiny, candidates are shortlisted for further processing.
 - The applicants are asked to give a demonstration lecture which is evaluated for a maximum of 40 marks. The evaluation of demonstration lecture will be done by a team of experts (internal and external). Based on this performance, candidates are shortlisted.
 - The shortlisted candidates are then asked to appear for interview wherein his/her performance is evaluated for a maximum of 10 marks.
 - On the basis of cumulative performance, recommendations will be done by Board of Appointments (BoA).
- The process of recruitment of **Assistant Professor** is devised as follows:
 - The applications received are scrutinized by a committee consisting of HoD and two senior staff of the concerned Department. Based on this scrutiny, candidates are shortlisted for further processing.
 - The applicants are asked to appear for a written test which is evaluated for a maximum of 50 marks. Syllabus as prescribed by GATE will be the basis for the questions of written test for engineering disciplines. For Basic Sciences, the written test will be as per 'UGC-NET / KSET' syllabus. Based on a cutoff, candidates will be shortlisted.
 - The shortlisted candidates will then undergo the following:
 - The applicants are asked to give a demonstration lecture which is evaluated for a maximum of 35 marks.
 - Further short listing of candidates at this stage is also done.
 - Then the shortlisted candidates are asked to appear for interview wherein his/her performance is evaluated for a maximum of 15 marks.
 - On the basis of cumulative performance, recommendations will be done by Board of Appointments (BoA).

The written test for Asst. Professor is likely to be scheduled during the 4th week of December 2018. Individual call letters will be sent in due course of time.
